

- 1. Persons who have reached the age of 18 are eligible to start.
- 2. The start must be from the allocated starting block. Starting from the wrong starting block will result in disqualification.
- **3.** The division of the starting groups is determined as follows:

A group/club must consist of at least 3 members.

Prizes are awarded to the largest group/club at the finish and the group/club with the best costume. The Furthest traveled group/club will also be rewarded.

Help may be accepted from teammates as well as from other participants.

The choice of route - 13.5 km or 7 km - does not have to be announced in advance. The route length can be decided spontaneously by the group/club for obstacle 13 (Arlberg tunnel).

If an obstacle is not completed by all group and club members the first time, all members must complete penalty exercises (squats, push-ups, etc.) in the designated area.

The entry fee must be paid with the registration. By registering, the participant accepts the regulations, the privacy policy and the exclusion of liability towards the organizer.

- **5.** Each participant is obliged to collect his/her race number in person and to wear it visibly during the inspection as well as during the race.
- **6.** The transponder, which is attached to the start number, must be returned before leaving the finish area. The participant is responsible for checking that the transponder is properly attached to the race number. Any complaints must be made directly when collecting the start numbers. Transponders that are not returned will be charged with a fee of 50 Euro
- 7. All instructions of the marshals must be followed.
- **8.** The organizing committee reserves the right to make any changes to the regulations in order to ensure a better race.
- **9.** The course conditions and the condition of the obstacles depend on the weather and may vary from participant to participant. In the event of bad weather conditions or other unforeseeable problems on the course, the race may be postponed, canceled or shortened. Participants will only receive a credit note for a new start date if the race is canceled.
- **10.** Complaints: Complaints must be submitted to the race management within 15 minutes of the official publication of the race results together with a deposit of Euro 50,00. The deposit will not be refunded if the complaint is unfounded.
- **11.** The following criteria are defined for the group and club classification:



Largest group/club:: Rating according to the number of finished group and club members. <u>Best costume:</u> Decision by a 3-member team. <u>Furthest traveled group/club:</u> The kilometers covered by the journey of all members are added together (source: Google Maps). Route calculation: Home address of the participants → St. Anton am Arlberg, Dorfstraße 8
